

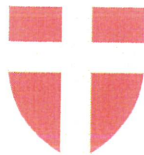

## I, Charles Anthony Gauci,

Chief Herald of Arms of Malta, Hereditary Noble in the Noblesse of Scotland, Count Gauci, Knight Commander of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, Gentleman-Officer in the Order of the Third Foreign Legion of the Kingdom of Spain, Doctor of Medicine of the Royal University of Malta, Fellow of the Royal College of Anaesthetists of England and Foundation Fellow of its Faculty of Pain Medicine, Fellow in Interventional Pain Practice of the World Institute of Pain, Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries of Scotland, sometime Lieutenant Colonel in the Royal Army Medical Corps &c.







## SEND GREETINGS

Whereas petition has been made unto me by Baron Dr. **Luciano Sini**, Master's Degree (Chemistry) Pacific Western University, Los Angeles, California, United States of America, Doctorate in Psychology, University of Ljubljana, Republic of Slovenia, Doctorate in Psychology, *Università degli studi Suor Orsola Benincasa*, Naples, Member, as a graduate of the University of Herisau, of the *Association Europeenne des Docteurs et Ingénieurs Spécialistes* of Freiburg, Switzerland, Knight, Order of the Lion of Rwanda, formerly Chemical Manager (Tanning), *Gruppo Mastrotto* Tannery, Vicenza, Italy and foreign technical consultant (research and development) in the Russian Federation, People's Republic of China and the Republic of Ukraine a citizen of Italy, residing in Cornedo Vicentino, Vicenza born in Marano Vicentino, Vicenza on 16th September 1944, the son of Giammaria Sini born in Ittiri, Sassari, Sardinia on 13th December 1901, deceased 17th November 1988 and of his spouse Rina Maria née Busato born in Thiene, Marano Vicentino, Vicenza on 4th August 1910, deceased 15th April 1995, setting forth that he is desirous that certain Armorial Ensigns, confirmed and registered to him, the said Luciano Sini by the Chronicler of Arms of Castile and León and sealed by the latter's proper Arms, in the Most Noble City of Sego-







via, on the 23rd January 2018, registered in his archive on the same day with number 04/2018 and notarised by José Ventura Nieto-Valencia Notary of the Illustrious College of Madrid and an Officer of the Kingdom of Spain on the same day, be registered at the Office of the Chief Herald of Arms of Malta without injury or prejudice to any other Armorial Ensigns, already in use, noting that the mantling Or doubled Argent in the said Arms has been removed by petitioner and replaced by a Baronial coronet to which he is fully entitled, the said Barony having been certified by the same Chronicler of Arms.

Know ye therefore that Now I, The Chief Herald of Arms of Malta, do by these Presents accordingly let all know that I declare myself pleased to uphold the said petition and therefore by virtue of the competence vested in me by authority as published in the Malta Government Gazette of the 25th June 2019 and by the authority and powers further vested in me under Chapter 445 of the Laws of Malta do by these same Presents herein (depict) and register in the Archives and Register of my Office the following Arms as held by the aforementioned **Luciano Sini** such as without injury or prejudice to any other he may forever bear to the end that the Officers of Arms there and all others upon occasion may take full notice and



have knowledge thereof. That is to say:

Or a swan proper (Argent) langued and armed Gules standing with one leg on a rocky mound proper. Above the shield is a baronial coronet.

And whereas the aforesaid authorities require that this registration of Arms be co-signed by the Chief Herald of Arms of Malta in the name of his Office and by the Registrar of the Office of the Chief Herald of Arms of Malta who shall attest that such Arms have been duly registered, and who subscribe their names and titles and affix the Seals of their Offices, this 8th day of April Two Thousand and Twenty-Four.
